CURRICULUM VITAE

- 1932 born in Berlin as a son of the librarian PhD Karl-Theodor Bayer and his wife Alice Bayer
- 1939 - 1942 elementary school in Berlin
- 1942 - 1948 evacuation from Berlin in/at various villages in Poland, Czechoslovakia and areas in south-eastern Germany without regular attendance at school
- 1949 -1953 A-levels (Goethe Grammar School, Frankfurt a. M.)
- 1953 -1955 vocational training as a banker
- 1955 -1961 studies (subjects: Germanic and English Philology, Pedagogy, Philosophy and Social Sciences at the University of Frankfurt, Marburg and London (as scholarship holder of the Studienstiftung des deutschen Volkes).
- 1962 - 1964 First and Second State Examination for teaching at grammar schools (Frankfurt a. M.)
- 1964 - 1970 teacher at grammar schools and at the Hessen-Kolleg (Frankfurt am Main)
- 1968 – 1970 Part-time delegation at the German Institute for International Pedagogical Research (DIPF, Frankfurt a. M.) for an additional course of study in educational science research (as project director) in the field of general and comparative educational science at the DIPF; Empirical and comparative research in Germany and countries of the EC and the Third World.
- 1975 PhD (educational science) at the University of Frankfurt a.M.: "Teacher training and pedagogical competence"
- 1976 - 1978 Appointment to the Centre for Teacher Training at the University of Gießen, managing the "coordination of the courses of studies for teachers"; In cooperation with the DIPF, comparative research on polytechnical concepts of „Bildung“ and their effects on the teacher training in selected countries were carried out (State Doctorate project)
- 1978 - 1982 appointed professor at the Pedagogical University Westfalen-Lippe and at the University of Bielefeld and Duisburg
- since 1972 research sojourns und short-time lectureships at universities in Great Britain, in Indonesia, in the Republic of Ireland, in Russia, in the USA and in connection with "research on *Bildung* with the Third World" (DGFE-Commission)
- since 1982 chairman / board member of the commission "School Pedagogy / Teacher Training" in the German Society for Educational Science; membership in international organisations which promote migrants, community projects, unemployed youngsters, the AHD, the ATEE, the GPPF, etc.
- since 1983 chairman of regional advancement and research in the Rhine-Ruhr-Area, i.e. "Integration of foreign children and youngsters"; "Community-orientated work on „Bildung“ and welfare with pupils" projects dedicated to the transition from school to employment or to the "Integration of Resettlers" etc.
- since 1988 co-founder und board member of the "Institute for Social and Cultural Research, incorporated society", Duisburg, which assists numerous temporal and regional limited projects and gives scientific advice
- 1989 - 1992 elected and re-elected dean of the Faculty 2 (Educational Science / Psychology) at the University of Duisburg
- 1991 - 1994 senate appointee of the University of Potsdam for teacher training and the implementation of the "Potsdam Model" in all courses of study in the field of teacher training of the state Brandenburg (in the framework of promoting relationships with universities in the states of Eastern Germany)
- from the beginning of the 90s management of further research projects: „EVA: Integration of resettlers in Germany's school, job and socio-cultural system“

3 autonomous projects lasting 2 years: and 1 subsequent project, also lasting 2 years, funded by the BMI und state funds: "Scientific assistance and cooperation in connection with measures for integrating migrants" in North-Rhine Westfalia (WIBKE). Both projects were carried out in cooperation with the ISK e.V. and the University of Duisburg.

since 1991 professor for Intercultural Pedagogy: beginning of relationships with Russian universities (i.e. with Barnaul, Saratow)

since 1996 and also with Uljanowsk) which are promoted by means of DAAD funds for "partnerships with the East"; the cooperation with Polish universities (i.e. with the University of Gdansk, based on mit DAAD funds) has already started in 1988.
